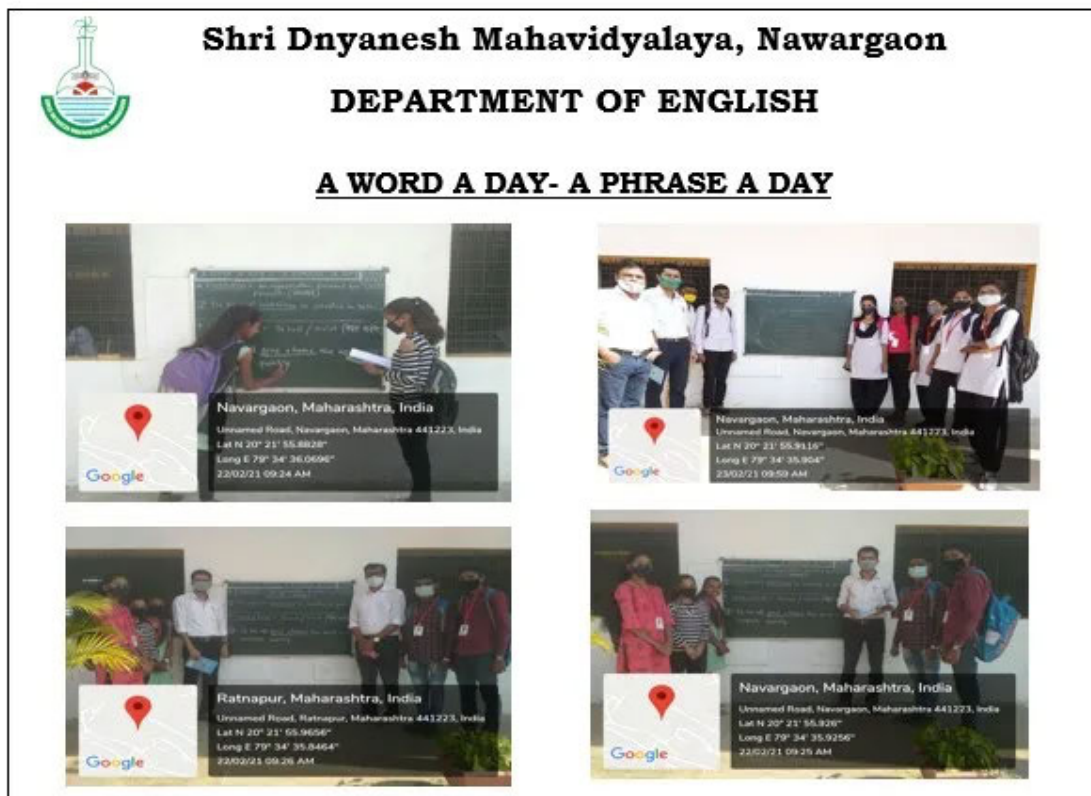
4. Evidence of Success


Respected Sir,
