In the meeting, necessary precaution was taken in the consideration of pandemic like sanitization of the meeting hall and use of mask.

In this academic session 2021-22, the institution revised the composition of IQAC. Due to untimely demise of IQAC member Dr. S.V. Nakade, Dr. G.S. Kotalwar is appointed as a member in IQAC. In the category of administrative officer, the head clerk of the institution Mr. Dnyaneshwar Borkar is appointed as a member. The student representative Ms. Poshna Agade who passed M.Sc. II (Chem) from the institution, IQAC appointed Mr. Vaibhav Mohurle

M.A. Part I (History) as a student representative. Dr. L.C. Ujeda is appointed as the coordinator of IQAC in place of former coordinator Dr. V.K. Rewatkar Madam.

Agenda and The Minutes

1. At the outset, principal Dr. Bakare congratulated the ~~new~~ newly appointed coordinator Dr. L.C. Ujeda as well as other newly appointed IQAC members: Dr. G.S. Kotalwar, Dnyaneshwar Borkar & Vaibhav Mohurle.

He also congratulated all the faculty members, supporting staff for their devoted contribution in the recent third cycle of NAAE. As a result, of NAAE awarded the institution with 'A' grade and The CGPA of 3.07.

Agenda

1. Appointment of Criteria Coordinator for the preparation of AQAR 20-21
For the preparation of AQAR 2020-21, The principal declared the names of Criteria Coordinators and appealed them all to collect the requisite documents. He also appealed that the information to be collected as early as possible and submitted to the IQAE to gear up the preparation of AQAR 2020-21. This year, along with the faculty members, some supporting staff members were also added for more help.
2. Best Practices of all the departments
Two best practices are needed

for the AQAR every year. The principal declared in the meeting that every year two best practices will be selected for AQAR. He appealed to all the faculty members that every department should show at least one best practice. All the best practices will be discussed and scrutinized and final two best practices will be incorporated in the AQAR. The principal appealed all the HoDs of all the departments to prepare at least one best practice.

3. Departmental Annual Reports

All the departments have conducted many curricular and co-curricular activities in the year 2020-21. Maximum activities are conducted on online platform. Principal Dr. Bakare in appealed all that all should prepare the departmental reports as soon as the activity is conducted and forward the soft copy to the newly prepared whatsapp group 'DMV AQAR 2020-21.'

4. Separate Reports on Activities

Many departments organised different activities, but at among them, some activities are special and significant activities which are important for the institution.

Principal Dr. Bakare appealed all to make independent reports of the significant activities conducted by the department.

5. Any other topic with the permission of the chairperson

Principal read and discussed the recommendations of the NAAE peer team visited the institution on 3rd & 4th August.

The discussion on the recommendations was as follows.

a. The short-term courses and add-on courses are to be given code numbers. Some short-term courses have to be introduced in the institution as per recommendation.

b. Research activities to be increased.

c. Recommendation: ERP to be more functional. The institution has been using Master Software for administrative purpose. It is recommended that the ERP should be used for academic purpose.

d. Recommendation: Communicative English and Soft Skills.

Principal appealed head of the department of English to invite guest from Nagpur for the students to deliver talk on Communicative and Soft Skills.

e. Rec.: New courses.

Principal declared that the proposal for UG in Commerce faculty has been forwarded to the university with all the requisite documentation.

f. Effective use of ICT - Recommendation
This year due to pandemic, all the academic, co-curricular and extra-curricular activities are conducted on online platform with the exception of some activities.

g. Recommendation: Interaction with local NGOs for consultancy.
The issue was discussed and principal

proposed to do MoU (Memorandum of Understanding) with NGOs like Forest department, Chandrapur and TATR (Tadoba Andhari Tiger Resort) for the purpose of training to the guides.

h. Recⁿ: NCC centre to be established

As per the recommendation to establish NCC training centre in the institution, principal declared that the procedure will be carried out soon in the coming future.

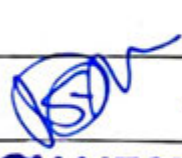
i. Recⁿ: MoU with industry
