

We are here proposing the area of collaboration and common points of consideration of an MOU which was wish to have with STAMI. Areas of Collaboration/interaction-

On its parts, the institute/Organization shall consider and try, to the extent possible-

- To share knowledge and expertise of the Researchers, students, faculties and other members of both the organizations on case to case basis with mutual consent.
- To provide resource persons for guest lecture/workshop etc. to the students and faculty development programs and research assignments of mutual interest.
- To get permission for visit of faculty members and the students to the various Institute / Organization as per mutually convenient dates and schedule.
- 4) To offer technical consultancy/training as per the need to the organization.
- 5) To offer the library/ infrastructure/other amenities/facility of the institute to the organization personnel if required by the organization as per a procedure which is mutually evolved.
- 6) To help and guide the institution to the best possible way for various future ventures in which faculty and students get benefits in carrying out research and related activities.
- To coordinate and co-operate for the organization of scientific events.

Common points of consideration-

- The MOU does not imply any kind of financial obligation, unless agreed upon in writing, on either side and neither party can claim for any financial charges.
- The association and activities carried out through the MOU should never be considered as an employment opportunity in any course of time by any individual concerned.

- 3) The MOU does not bind or compel either party to provide for the above mentioned favours to the other party and rather aims to build and foster a spirit of Collaboration for the mutual benefit while protecting the individual and mutual interests.
- 4) The MOU shall be effective from the date of signing/approval through official mail and either party can terminate this arrangement by a simple written communication by a competent authority at any point of time else will be in force for the 12 months only from the date of approval. In case the institutions wish to continue for further has to again sign this MOU for extended period of time. The extension period can be for 12 months only. In case both the parties wish to continue this MOU in future need to sign this MOU in subsequent years.
- 5) Neither party shall be liable for any indirect, punitive, special, incidental or consequential damages arising out of or in connection with this understanding, whether for breach of this MOU or in torts, including loss of business, data, revenue and profits or for any third party claims against the other whatsoever.
