The two agencies will:

- Have practical training at Shri Dnyanesh Mahavidyalaya, Nawargaon Tq. Sindewahi, Dist. Chandrapur & Wildcat Resort, Wasera, Dist Chandrapur depending on the nature of work as per rules of the institute, facilities and requirements.
- Endeavour the visits of students to Wildcat Resort Wasera, Dist Chandrapur to
 provide them with an exposure to operations and services of hotel and tourism industry,
 etc.
- Initiating Short Term Skill-based and Career Oriented Courses which can be a great way to create the skills and to provides employment opportunities to the students.

Therefore, the above said agencies intend to co-operate and focus their efforts and co-operations within such area.

The agencies to this MoU undertake to treat as CONFIDENTIAL AND PRIVILEGED INFORMATION. The terms of confidentiality and mode of disclosure shall be as per mutually acceptable terms.

This MoU shall require the ratification of the competent authorities of both the agencies.

- In order to carry out the above activities, a detailed plan may be agreed on consultation between the two agencies.
- It is implicit that every activity carried out under this agreement is approved by the appropriate officials at each agency and must fall within each agency's constraints.
- 3. This agreement will take effect from the date of its signing and shall be valid initially for 05 years' period from that date unless sooner terminated, revoked or modified by mutual agreement. However, termination of the MoU will not in any manner affect the interests the MoU.
