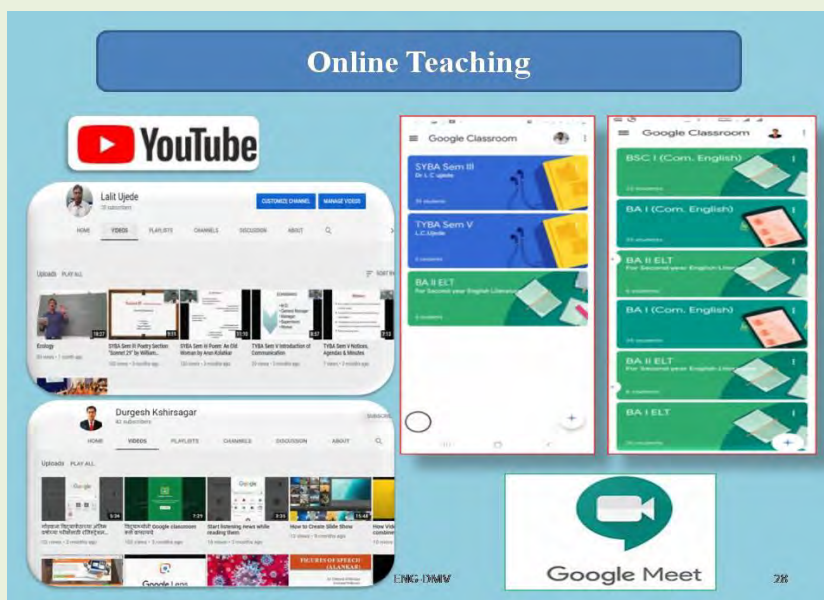

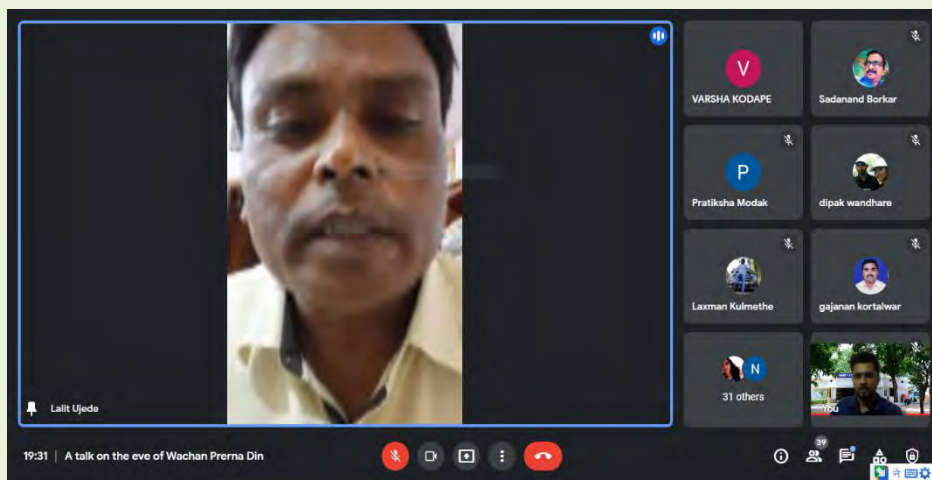

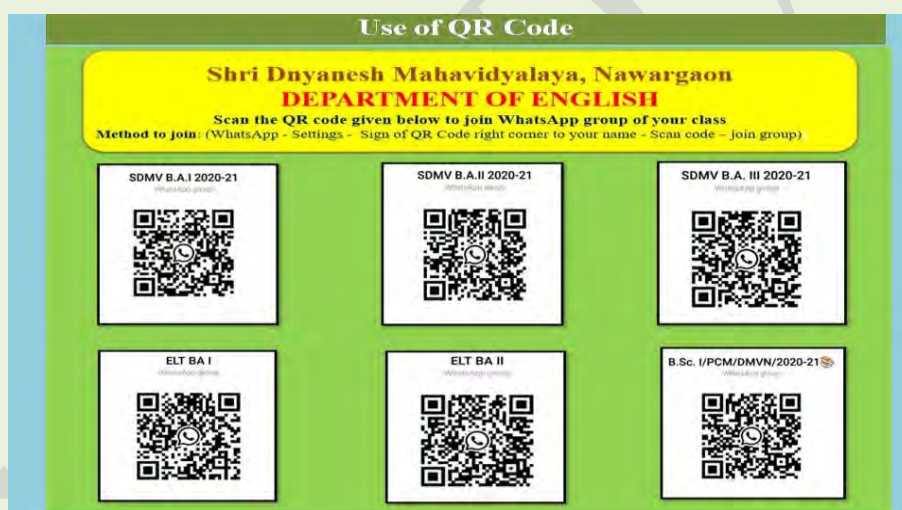
#### 15. Best Practices of the Department

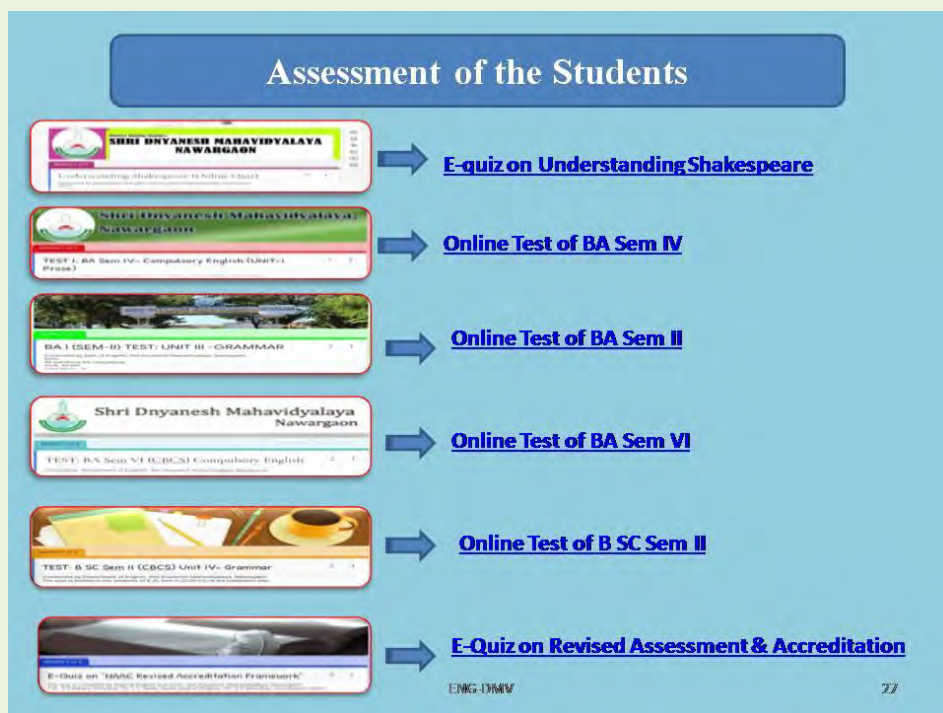
